Hidden motion:

“By a majority vote without debate, the reading of the minutes can be “dispensed with”--that is, *not carried out at the regular time*. If the reading of the minutes is dispensed with, it can be ordered (by majority vote without debate) at any later time during the meeting while no business is pending; and if it is not thus taken up before adjournment, these minutes must be read at the following meeting before the reading of the later minutes. If it is desired to approve the minutes without having them read, it is necessary to suspend the rules for this purpose.” – RONR page 456 line 33 ff.
